Run 2078 – Orig goes around Craigie Open Space

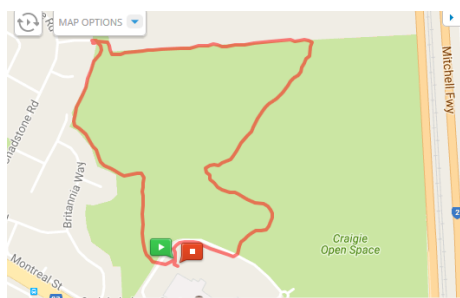
Preamble:
