Preamble:

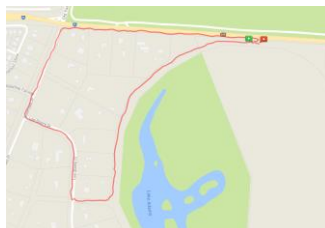
